Goals & Objectives

Friends of the Library works to stimulate the connection between the Cedarburg community and the Cedarburg Public Library; to increase the understanding and usage of CPL services and programs, to support the CPL by fundraising for enhancements to the Library and to foster community within library users.

Purpose

Our Bylaws state "The purpose of Cedarburg Friends of the Library shall be to foster closer relations between the Cedarburg Public Library and the citizens of the Cedarburg area; to promote knowledge of the functions, resources, services and needs of the Library; to assist in the development of educational and literary programming; and to encourage the continuing development of library facilities."

Board Structure

The Board of Directors has between 10 and 25 members. Each member is elected for a term of 3 years and may serve for two consecutive terms but then must take a hiatus of one year. The Executive Board consists of a President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Correspondence Secretary, Treasurer and Past President. This is a 'working' board with all members participating in activities and committee positions.

Activities

The CFOL Board serves as the organizers of several major fundraising used book sales. We have also held events such as 'Cedarburg Reads' and sponsor programs and events at the Library. The Friends are expanding their Friends Only activities.

Commitment

Board members are required to attend monthly meetings, typically held on the first Wednesday at 6:30 pm in the Community Room of the CPL. Meetings generally last 1-2 hours. Sub Committees may also hold meetings outside of Board meetings where the bulk of CFOL business is accomplished. Board member participation is required for us to accomplish our goals and enhance our Library.

Benefits

The CFOL Board has a close connection to the Library's information, events, programs, and services. Board members are a cross section of the community who enjoy a comradarie with each other, sharing their appreciation of literature and all the amenities that a library offers. We find great satisfaction in assisting Cedarburg's state of the art Library for the benefit of our whole community.
