

WDL for eAudiobooks on Computer Desktop

You can borrow eAudiobooks from your library and transfer them to your Windows or Mac computer using the OverDrive Media Console application.

Step 1

Download the OverDrive Media Console application to your computer. You may find it by opening your computer web browser and going to <http://app.overdrive.com/>

Step 2

View Wisconsin's Digital Library (WDL) electronic book collection.

- Open the web browser on your computer and go to www.cedarburglibrary.org
- Under the Get Started menu, select eBooks and eAudiobooks.
- Sign into the WDL website by selecting Monarch Library System and using your library card barcode and PIN (the last four digits of your phone number).
- Find a title by using the search bar or browsing by collection or subject. Click Borrow to borrow a title or Place a Hold to be added to the wait list.

Step 3

Download titles to the OverDrive Media Console application on your computer's desktop.

- To do this, go to your Loans shelf from the My Account drop down menu in Wisconsin's Digital Library.
- Find the title you wish to download, then select Download MP3 Audiobook.

If prompted, create an OverDrive account. It will require nothing more than your name and email address.

Step 4

Downloaded eAudiobooks should open in the OverDrive Media Console application automatically.

Notes:

1. You can transfer MP3 eAudiobooks to an audio device—such as an iPod—by connecting the device via a USB cord, selecting the title you wish to transfer, and selecting the Transfer icon in OverDrive Media Player.
