



WDL for eReaders

You can borrow eBooks from your library and transfer them to compatible eReaders using free Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) software on your Windows or Mac computer.

If you have a Kindle eReader, please refer to the instructions specific to Kindle eReaders.

Step 1

Download Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) to your computer. You will find ADE by opening your web browser and doing a Google search for “Adobe Digital Editions download” or entering <http://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html> in the browser’s address bar.

Note: *In order to get eBooks on a Sony Reader Wi-Fi, you'll need to install Sony Reader software on your computer instead of Adobe Digital Editions.*

Step 2

Connect your eReader to your computer using your eReader’s USB cord.

Step 3

View Wisconsin’s Digital Library electronic book collection.

- Open the web browser on your computer and go to www.cedarburglibrary.org
- Under the Get Started menu, select eBooks and eAudiobooks.
- Sign into the Wisconsin’s Digital Library website by selecting Monarch Library System followed by your library card barcode and PIN (the last four digits of your phone number).
- Find a title by using the search bar or browsing by collection or subject. Click Borrow to borrow a title or Place a Hold to be added to a wait list.

Step 4

Download titles to the Adobe Digital Editions application on your computer’s desktop.

- To do this, select the books icon in the upper right corner of your Wisconsin’s Digital Library screen. This will bring you to your Loans shelf with books ready for download.
- Find the title you wish to download and select Choose a File, then EPUB eBook file format.



If prompted, authorize your computer with a free Adobe ID (this is required for downloading protected eBooks). If you don't have an Adobe ID, you'll see a link to create one.

Step 5

Downloaded eBooks should open in Adobe Digital Editions automatically. To transfer an eBook to your eReader, make sure you are in ADE's "Library View" (you may need to click the **Library** button in the upper-left corner to get there). From there, drag and drop the eBook into your eReader, which should appear on the left column under "Devices."

Once you've transferred a library eBook, you can read it on your device.

Notes:

1. During the transfer process, your eReader will be automatically authorized with the same Adobe ID you used on your computer.
2. If you're using a Sony Reader and it isn't recognized by ADE, you may need to install and use the Sony Reader software to transfer eBooks.
