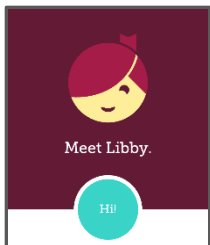
New technology coming to CPL

Cedarburg Public Library's Technology Vision Statement expresses that our Board of Trustees is committed to supporting, updating, and funding technology in three broad areas for the library: leading edge innovative technology, practical "daily use" technology, and "behind the scenes" infrastructure. CPL is focusing on technology this year and has received generous support from the Greater Cedarburg Foundation and the Cedarburg Friends of the Library Fund at the Greater Milwaukee Foundation. Their support will fund new technology endeavors beginning in August 2017 and going into 2018. There are four main phases/technologies



coming to CPL: Adobe Creative Cloud (August 2017); Virtual Reality (September 2017); Digitization Lab (January 2018); and Drones (April 2018). OverDrive app changes to Libby



OverDrive has updated the app used for downloading e-materials from Wisconsin's Digital Library. The new and improved app is called Libby. The process will work very similarly as with the OverDrive app. The FREE Libby app is available for iOS, Android, and Windows 10 devices from the Apple Store, Google Play Store, and Microsoft Store. All other devices, including Kindle Fire tablets, should continue to use the older OverDrive app or the Kindle

format for downloading books. Please ask at the 2nd floor Information Desk for further guidance, including step-by-step handouts. There is also a computer class on Libby for eBooks and eAudiobooks on Monday, August 28 at 2:00 pm. Please register in advance.
