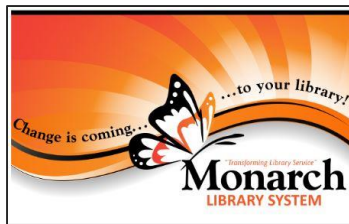

WHAT'S NEW?

Service Interruption: Dec 8th-14th

The Eastern Shores and Mid-Wisconsin Library Systems are in the process of merging to create the Monarch Library System, comprised of the public libraries in Ozaukee, Sheboygan, Dodge, and Washington counties. As part of this merge, the two systems' catalogs will go through a catalog migration process from December 8th-14th, 2016. The new Monarch catalog will replace Easicat but look very similar and have 18 more libraries and thousands of more resources to choose from. To best serve you, **Cedarburg Public Library will remain open during the above time period**, but library services will be limited in all four counties. The library catalog will not be available; thus, you will not be able to search the catalog, renew or request items, make payments, or register for cards. You will be able to check out items in our building; use public computers, wi-fi, study rooms, etc.; and you can access our online databases such as BadgerLink, Ancestry Library Edition, Reference USA, Pronunciator, Wisconsin's Digital Library, Zinio, and others. No items are due during this offline period, but the outside and inside book drops are available for your convenience. Thank you for your patience during this downtime. Please ask library staff with any further questions.
