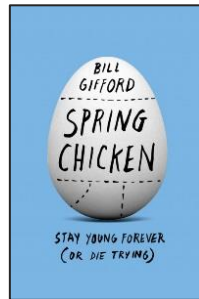
## WHAT'S NEW?
