Two Women Take on Big Water



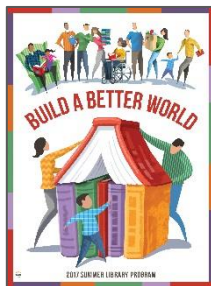
