## WHAT'S NEW?

### Summer Reading Program begins!

Our Summer Reading Program begins in June! The theme this year is centered on wellness, fitness, and sports with the following slogans for different age groups: “On Your Mark, Get Set, Read!” (children); “Get in the Game: Read” (teens); and “Exercise Your Mind. Read!” (adults). The adult program will take place June 1<sup>st</sup>- August 26<sup>th</sup>. It includes weekly prize drawings and special events. Adults may stop by the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Info Desk to register, starting on June 1<sup>st</sup>. The children and teen programs will take place June 11<sup>th</sup>- July 30<sup>th</sup>. Youth, stop by the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Info Desk, and teens, stop by the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Info Desk to register, starting June 11<sup>th</sup>. ### CPL laptops now available

CPL now has laptops available for check out! The laptops have a 4-hour loan period and must stay in the library building. The cost is \$1 per checkout. Adults 18 years or older with an Eastern Shores Library System library card in good standing are eligible for this service. They are available at the Check-Out Desk on a first-come, first-served basis.

### Book Drop instructions

Cedarburg Public Library has a drive-up book return for your convenience. It is located behind the building – just follow the arrows around the circle drive. To use the book drop, follow these steps:

- 1) Press the green light, and the door will open.
- 2) Place one item at a time straight onto the conveyor belt. **Do not stack or enter items sideways. Doing so will cause the sorter to jam.**
- 3) When the receipt button lights up, PRESS. It is not necessary to have a receipt. All the items returned through the drop will be processed in a timely manner.
