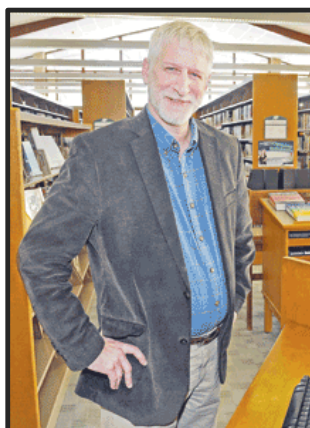
Great Decisions Series
