Potential merger of library systems

The Eastern Shores Library System, which CPL is a part of, and the Mid-Wisconsin Federated Library System are in the first round of discussion to see if a merged library system of the four counties (Ozaukee, Sheboygan, Washington, & Dodge) makes sense. Centralizing the system and services may lead to reduced costs to the libraries and a potential increase in services, including doubling the size of materials available. At this point several committees, library directors, library boards, and county boards are discussing and investigating if the idea is worthy of further consideration.
