WHAT'S NEW?

Coding & Drones: Basics | Oct. 6 * 1:00 pm & Oct. 9 * 5pm

Learn the basics of code building to program a Parrot Mambo drone! Every participant will get a Chromebook and their own drone to perform the programming. All ages with parental supervision for kids under 12. Registration required.

Drone Team Challenges! | Oct. 6 * 2:30 pm

You must complete Basic Level 1 to participate. Teams of three will battle it out in friendly competition. Up to 12 people may sign up as teams will alternate in and out. Teams will be decided at the program. All ages. Registration required.
