MILWAUKEE 53206: November 20th

This month's Monday Motivation program is a screening of the documentary *MILWAUKEE 53206* on Monday, November 20 at 6:00 pm. Following the 55 min. film, there will be group discussion. This event is sponsored by the Cedarburg Friends of the Library. No registration is required. *MILWAUKEE 53206* chronicles the lives of those affected by incarceration in America's most incarcerated ZIP code. Through the intimate stories of three 53206 residents, we witness the high toll mass incarceration takes on individuals and families in the community. The film not only examines Milwaukee's ZIP code 53206, but also illuminates the story of people from across the United States who live with the daily effects of mass incarceration.
