Library Card Sign-up Month

September is Library Card Sign-up Month! This began in 1987 when the then Secretary of Education Bennett challenged the nation saying, "Let's have a national campaign... every child should obtain a library card – and use it." Since then, libraries join in this effort every fall to encourage children (and adults!) to get a library card. CPL will give out FREE replacement library cards the whole month of September to anyone who has lost theirs (usually it is a \$3 replacement fee). It's always FREE to get your first library card. You must be at least five years old to get a card, and children 18 and under require a parent/guardian to be present. Stop by and get your library card today!
